CRITERIA FOR NOMINATIONS

Any Middle Tennessee organization, company or agency may be nominated.

Nominees must have demonstrated advocacy for older adults and/or corporate social responsibility efforts that make a significant and positive impact on the lives of older adults in Middle Tennessee.

THE SELECTION

The Sage Awards Committee is responsible for the selection of honorees and is comprised of past Sage Award recipients, COA board members, and community volunteers.

DEADLINE FOR NOMINATIONS

Recipients will be honored at the 2021 Sage Awards Luncheon on Monday, May 10th.

The recipient is required to be present for the award presentation at the luncheon.

Nominations must be submitted, mailed or emailed by Wednesday, September 30, 2020.
